Work Permit

Simple facts:

- ✓ Only for International Degree Students who hold an ARC
- ✓ Working without holding a work permit → may be fined from NT\$30,000 to NT\$150,000 and/or ordered to leave the country
- ✓ Application fee: 100 NTD.
- ✓ Valid from September 31 to March 31, or from March 31 to September 31.
- ✓ Maximum work hours: 20 hours/week, except during summer and winter vacation.
