Committee members: CE Department Professors will be invited to select the winning works in accordance with the principles of fairness. Presentation: The finalist teams should come in person to the CE Department to present the design concept in mid-March 2023.

Award announced: April 2023

7. Awards:

First prize (1 team): NT\$20,000 and a certificate. The finalist (3 to 5 teams): NT\$3,000 and a certificate per team.

- 8. Remarks:
 - (1) The organizer shall have the rights to utilize, including but not limited to modify, adjust, or duplicate the works in different formats, including but not limited to typesetting and printing, for promotional and exhibition purposes.
 - (2) Incomplete registration information and works in the incorrect format which affects the evaluation results would be deemed as invalid entries and would not be included in the selection process. Participants should have no objection to this.
 - (3) All entries will not be returned. Participants should keep their own drafts or backups.
 - (4) If none of the entries meet the evaluation criteria, the prize would not be awarded.
 - (5) After the finalist list is announced, in order to receive the prize, each winning team should identify at least one member to be a CE student.
