2. Part-Time Jobs or Internships in Taiwan

Simple Facts for Work Permit:

- Only for International Degree Students who hold an ARC.
- ✓ Application fee: NT\$100.
- ✓ Valid: September 30 to March 31, or March 31 to September 30 (maximum 6 mths).
- Maximum work hours: 20 hours/week, except during summer and winter vacation.



Work Permit

International students who would like to do part-time jobs or internships in Taiwan (either on or off campus) are required to have a valid work permit before starting work. Please note that if you hold a job without a work permit, you may be fined from NTD 30,000 to NTD 150,000 and expelled from Taiwan immediately. The maximum working time for students is 20 hours per week, except during summer and winter vacation.

The maximum validity period of a work permit is six months. For applications made in the fall semester, the work permit will be expire on March 31th of following year at the latest. For applications made in the spring semester, the work permit will expire on September 30th of the same year at the latest.

Work Permit Application Process

- 1. For first time applicants, please refer to the manual above and create an account on the application system first.
- 2. Please select "foreign students 4 year universities," "foreign students Master," or "foreign students Doctor" for the "Identity" column.
- 3. Please fill in full department name in Chinese for the "Faculty" column (please refer to your department website or your student ID card).

4. After you have submitted the online application, please inform the administrative staff at your department complete the application review. Your application will be submitted to OIA only after it has been approved by your department.



HOW TO EDIT YOUR E-PORTFOLIO



1. Go to "MyNTU" website, log in into your account and go to the "Students" tab.

Under the "Students" tab, you can find "NTU ePortfolio" and click on it.
