Dual Degree Program Application Guidelines 2025/2026 Academic Year

Department of Civil Engineering, College of Engineering, National Taiwan University

I. Overview of the Dual Degree Program and Degree Conferral

- 1. Our department has signed agreements with partner universities to recognize course credits mutually. After completing at least one year of study in our department, students may study at a partner university. Upon meeting graduation requirements, students will be awarded degrees from both universities. Students benefit from language, academic, and cultural exchanges while also enhancing their international competitiveness by earning degrees from NTU and the partner university.
- 2. Types of Dual Degree Programs:
 - 1.) Within the Same Degree Level (Bachelor's /Master's /Doctorate): Students will earn degrees from both universities (Bachelor's, Master's, or Doctorate) after satisfying the graduation requirements of both institutions.
 - 2.) Cross-Level Bachelor-Master Dual Degree: Undergraduate students complete the first three years of study at NTU and their fourth year at a partner university. After fulfilling NTU's graduation requirements, they receive a Bachelor's degree from NTU. In the fifth year, they continue graduate studies at the partner university and, upon fulfilling its graduation requirements, receive a Master's degree from the partner institution.

II. Study Period for the Dual Degree Program

For Kyushu University in Japan, the study period begins in April 2025 (NTU's 113-2 semester), while for other partner universities, the semester begins in Fall 2025 (114-1 semester). The exact study period will depend on the academic calendar or agreement of the partner institution.

III. Selection Process

- 1. The department will review the submitted documents and a comprehensive assessment will be made. If students pass the internal review, they will be nominated to the partner universities.
- 2. After the department's nomination, the partner institution retains the right to arrange additional review procedures.
- Agreements made with partner universities regarding the selection process will precede these guidelines.

IV. Application Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be current NTU students in at least their first year of a bachelor's or graduate program and meet the academic performance, language proficiency, and other admission requirements of the partner universities (see Appendix I for details).
- 2. The following students are not eligible to apply:
 - 1.) Those who have previously participated in a dual degree program within the same educational level (bachelor's, master's, or doctorate) at NTU, college, or department level.
 - 2.) Students enrolled in the Executive Master's Degree Program

V. Application Documents, Instructions, and Submission Notes

- 1. The following documents must be submitted in English:
 - 1.) Application form.
 - 2.) A full transcript is required, and it must be an official copy. First-year students should include their full transcripts from their previous degree level.
 - 3.) Proof of English language proficiency:
 - a. A copy of an official certification meeting the language requirements of the partner institution must be provided.
 - b. If the primary language of the partner institution is the applicant's native language, this proof may be waived.
 - 4.) Copy of passport.
 - 5.) Curriculum vitae.
 - 6.) Personal statement/ A statement of purpose essay.
 - 7.) Study plan: Please include a course plan for the study period at NTU and the partner institution.

 Graduate students should also include a research plan and a timeline for thesis completion.
 - 8.) Any other supporting documents.

2. Submission Notes:

- 1.) Before submission, collect the dual degree application fee payment slip from the Department of Civil Engineering office, pay at the Cashier Section, and submit the receipt and the application materials to the program coordinator.
- 2.) If submitted on behalf of the applicant, a signed authorization letter must be included.
- 3.) Once the application is submitted, requests for document return or fee refunds will not be accepted. All submitted documents will not be returned, so applicants are advised to keep copies.
- 4.) Incomplete or late submissions will not be processed.

VII. Payment and Refund Regulations for Overseas Dual Degree Program

- 1. According to NTU's tuition fee standards, students studying abroad in a dual degree program must still pay the full tuition, fees, and administrative costs to NTU for each semester while studying abroad.
- The administrative fee standards for overseas dual degree programs organized by the department include an application fee of 300 NTD and an administrative management fee of 1,000 NTD. The application fee must be paid along with the submission of the application materials for the dual degree program.
- 3. Once accepted by the partner school, students participating in the dual degree programs organized by the department (including those extending their studies) must pay the administrative management fee in full; once paid, it is non-refundable, regardless of whether the student completes the entire program. Refunds for tuition and fees will be processed in accordance with NTU's refund policy for students who withdraw or take a leave of absence.

VIII. Scholarships and Financial Aid

- 1. Outstanding students with financial difficulties may apply for a tuition fee waiver. A financial difficulty statement in Chinese or English must be provided.
- 2. The department may adjust the available scholarships for the dual degree program based on the annual budget and student applications.

Appendix II:

I. Admission Notes:

- 1. Admission is only valid for the 2025/2026 academic year. If the student cannot enroll on time, the admission will be canceled without deferral.
- 2. Admission indicates that the student has been recommended for the dual degree program by the department but still requires approval from the partner institution. If the student is not accepted or is unable to obtain a student visa, the admission is revoked. The department is not responsible for assisting with re-application or visa issues.
- 3. Students must participate in the dual degree program under the status they held during the selection process. Bachelor's students who later enroll in NTU's graduate school cannot switch to participating as graduate students; similarly, those who apply as master's students must continue as such.
- 4. Students must accept any changes in application materials or conditions required by the partner institution without objection.
- 5. If the partner institution requests contract modifications, the department will negotiate with the admitted students to adjust the program content.
- 6. In addition to regular student insurance, students must purchase comprehensive insurance (including medical, accident, and emergency assistance) before departure. If the partner institution offers insurance, students may choose to purchase it upon arrival. If insurance is not purchased, the department reserves the right to revoke the student's admission.
- 7. Admitted students are responsible for handling their accommodation, visas, airfare, airport transportation, course registration, transcripts, credit transfer, and insurance.
- 8. International degree students receiving a Taiwan Scholarship will have their scholarship canceled if they participate in the dual degree program abroad. The remaining scholarship duration cannot be retained or extended.
- 9. Students who graduate or take a leave of absence after being nominated for the dual degree program will lose their dual degree student status. Approval from the department is required to complete the procedures with the Academic Affairs Office. In the event of force majeure or legitimate reasons, the department may handle the situation accordingly.
- 10. Male students subject to conscription must complete the necessary procedures for overseas leave and return to Taiwan upon completion of the dual degree program. Failure to comply will result in legal consequences and disciplinary action according to university regulations.
- 11. In case of force majeure or legitimate reasons, students wishing to terminate the dual degree program early must obtain approval from both institutions. They cannot unilaterally end the program and return

to Taiwan.

II. Course Selection, Credits, and Grades:

- Students approved for the dual degree program must accumulate at least one-third of the required total credits for graduation at both NTU and the partner institution. Additional requirements specified in the agreement must also be followed.
- 2. Approved students may transfer credits earned at the partner institution back to NTU following NTU's academic regulations.
- 3. If a student is unable to complete their studies at the partner institution but has not exceeded the maximum study period defined by NTU, they may apply to return to NTU by submitting a report and relevant documents at least two weeks before the start of the semester, as per NTU's academic calendar.
- 4. All other matters will be handled according to the regulations of the Office of Academic Affairs.

III. Responsibilities and Obligations of Dual Degree Students:

- Once registered at the partner institution, students are considered students of that institution and must comply with all its regulations. Any conduct damaging the reputation of either institution will result in disciplinary actions from both, such as being reported to the student conduct committee.
- Students must stay in close contact with NTU during their time abroad and remain aware of their safety.
- 3. Students are responsible for promoting NTU's Department of Civil Engineering while abroad and are encouraged to participate in relevant events, such as dual degree student fairs or information sessions.
- 4. Within two months of completing the program, students must submit and agree to the public sharing of their dual degree program experience. The department reserves the right to use these reflections for promotional materials without further consent.
- 5. Before graduation, students must assist and mentor current NTU students by providing relevant advice and necessary information.
